Conrad Prebys Performing Arts Center La Jolla, California

The Conrad serves as both the permanent home of La Jolla Music Society and as a vital community resource for cultural arts programming and education. Conceived as a 'performing arts village', a stunning 513-seat concert hall, a 2,000-square foot flexible performance space, and a rehearsal room cluster around a garden courtyard,

encouraging patrons and artists from various events to intermingle and share the energy and experience of the performance. In the concert hall, an innovative tension wire grid design coupled with wooden grillwork on the upstage wall conceals the multitude of technology systems and contributes to the room's visual aesthetics.
